

LAZARUS AND MAGGIE YEGHNAZAR

Lazarus and Maggie were both born and brought up in Iran, each making their own commitment of faith to Jesus as children, and growing up with a passionate commitment to serve the church. They felt God call them to leave Iran in 1988, to plant churches and train leaders; this became what they founded as 222 Ministries International. Lazarus is President and CEO and Maggie leads both the ministry to women and 222 Publications. 222 has been a pioneer in many areas of Farsi Christian ministry, including satellite television broadcast, the internet and on-line theological training. The period since the 1979 Revolution has witnessed a remarkable outpouring of God's grace on Iranian people. Lazarus and Maggie are thankful to have witnessed so many transformed lives; their records indicate over 100,000 have so far been brought to Christ through 222. Their core passion remains to train leaders and plant churches to see 'Iran Changed for Christ'.



PASTOR AGU

Pastor Agu is a law graduate of the University of Warwick, UK. A former investment banker and partner in a law firm; he is now the Senior Pastor of Jesus House for All Nations London. He oversees over 600 parishes in his capacity as the Chairman of the Executive Council of the Redeemed Christian Church of God, UK.

He is the Chair of the organising committee of the Festival of Life, the largest prayer gathering of its kind in Europe with an attendance of over 45,000 people at each of its biannual programs.

Pastor Agu is also a key member of the One People Commission of the Evangelical Alliance. A body set up to integrate black majority churches more fully into the Evangelical Alliance.

He was voted Britain's most inspirational black person of 2012 in a poll conducted by the mayor of London's office and the London Metro.

SPEAKERS



MIKE PILAVACHI

Mike heads up Soul Survivor ministries (a charity that aims to equip young people to live their lives for Jesus) as well as pastoring the associated church – Soul Survivor Watford. Mike speaks at conferences around the world, trying to make people laugh and point them towards Jesus at the same time. He has written a number of books the latest of which is called Everyday Supernatural.



JON TYSON

Jon is a pastor and church planter in New York City. Originally from Australia, Jon moved to the United States twenty years ago with a passion to seek and cultivate renewal in the Western Church. He has had extensive experience in the area of city centre church planting, and is passionate about integrating deep theology with the power of the Holy Spirit. He is the author of Sacred Roots, A Creative Minority and the forthcoming book, The Burden is Light. Jon lives in the Hell's Kitchen neighbourhood of Manhattan with his wife and two children. He serves as the Lead Pastor of Church of the City New York.



JOHN AND DEBBY WRIGHT

John & Debby are the National Directors of the movement and have been serving together in pastoral ministry since 1990. John initially trained and worked for a number of years as a jeweller before studying at London Bible College. Debby lived in Chile until she was 13 and later moved to Nottingham to train as a dancer and artist.

They first got involved with the Vineyard movement in 1982 and in 1987 they spent 8 months as interns at Anaheim Vineyard (under John Wimber the leader of the Vineyard Movement in the USA). Following their time at Anaheim they returned to England to help John and Eleanor Mumford start the first UK Vineyard in London. They worked at South West London Vineyard for 9 years before moving back to Nottingham to set up Trent Vineyard.

In September 2015 they became the National Directors of Vineyard Churches UK & Ireland, whilst also continuing to lead Trent Vineyard.

Together they now focus on helping facilitate the growth of the Vineyard internationally and speaking around the world.

Born in Iran to an Armenian Christian family, Lazarus has been in ministry to Iran since childhood where he met and married his childhood sweetheart, Margaret. After the Iran-Iraq war they moved to England and founded 222 Ministries. 222 Ministries has established churches in 50 Iranian cities and 16 countries, pioneering a Farsi Christian news agency, online Bible college and internet. In 2002, he started Iranian Christian Broadcasting producing Farsi Christian television programs reaching Iran, Afghanistan and Europe.

She leads the '222 Women's ministries', as well as 'Publications' and 'Farsi Freedom in Christ'. She is internationally recognised speaker for Iranian women and often organises and leads women's conferences.

Lots of churches around the UK and Ireland, including some in the Vineyard, are exploring what it would mean to do worship, ministry and mission in multiple locations across their city or region. Leading a worship ministry in a small university town with rapid turnover of young members, Jesse has learned valuable lessons about building successfully with the materials that God provides, rather than struggling to produce replications of other much-loved worship expressions. This continually requires taking risks on people sooner than is comfortable, the result being a worship ministry that is authentic, messy, exciting, scary, and utterly dependent on the Holy Spirit.

If you're a leader who wants to help worship grow but you don't know how, this seminar will explore the essential building blocks for a healthy worship ministry.

Jesse Duley (MTheol) is the Worship Pastor at the Kingdom Vineyard in St Andrews, Scotland.

Nick Sutton has led the Missions Team for VCUKI since June 2016, along with his wife, Vicki, he also leads Coventry Vineyard. The Missions Team exists to mobilise Vineyard Churches, by; (i) encouraging clarity, good communication and healthy accountability as we coordinate the missions work of VCUKI at a strategic level through partnerships; (ii) facilitating church planting movements in other nations by serving and raising up indigenous leaders to pastor their communities; (iii) encouraging activities and organisations that promote compassion and justice internationally.



QUESTION - A SIMPLE
TOOL TO LEAD PEOPLE
TO FAITH ANYWHERE**

MARK MARX - Y7

Mark will share simple steps to help you begin a conversation with anyone, open up possibilities to pray, share the gospel and lead them to Jesus. After this session there will be opportunity to put it straight into practice going out onto the streets of Nottingham.

Mark is part of the Causeway Coast Vineyard church, and founder of Healing on the Streets. He moved to Northern Ireland in 1988, with his wife Linda and their three sons. Mark pioneered the development of the Healing on the Streets ministry, which has seen the church praying for people on the streets every week since Easter 2005. 


